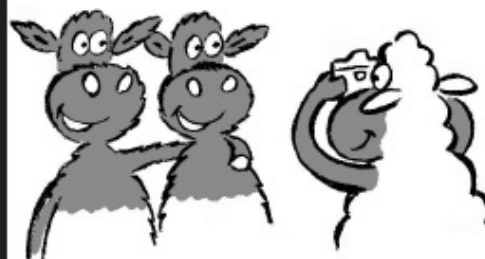

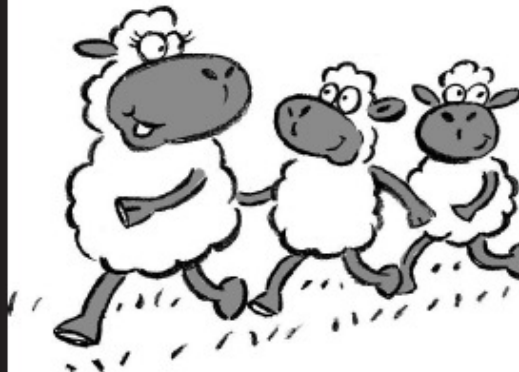


Avoid damage to drystone walls, barns and other buildings.

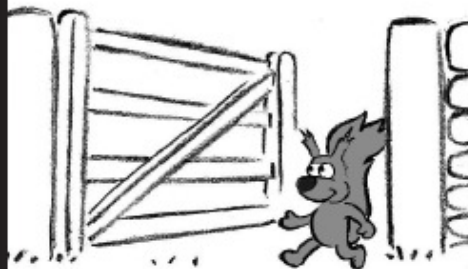


Many areas are open to explore - please keep to footpaths, tracks and access areas.

Use gates and stiles to cross walls, fences and hedges.



Leave gates as they are found, whether open or closed.



Leave livestock, crops and machinery well alone.
