(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF PEDESTRIANS)

(FOOTPATH NO. 11, CONISTONE-WITH-KILNSEY) ORDER 2019 No. 2

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1) (as amended)

Notice is hereby given that the Yorkshire Dales National Park Authority has made an Order, the effect of which is to prohibit any pedestrian from proceeding along Footpath No. 11 from the point of closure at Grid Reference SD 9749 6806 for a distance of approximately 745 metres to Grid Reference SD 9785 6751 in the Parish of Conistone-with-Kilnsey in the district of Craven from 2 September, 2019 until 2 March, 2020 inclusive.

The closure will be put into effect when necessary by means of the erection of notices and signs.

The Order is necessary because works are proposed to be executed to the surface of the Footpath for the purpose of installing a new pipeline. Mott MacDonald Bentley will be replacing the Kilnsey sewerage rising main on behalf of Yorkshire Water. The footpath closure is required to ensure public safety as there will be large and heavy plant in daily operation on the site which would pose a serious health and safety risk.

There is no safe, suitable alternative route to be used during the closure period.
