**(FOOTPATH NO. 37 (PART), ARKENGARTHDALE)
ORDER 2019, No. 14**

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1) (as amended)

Notice is hereby given that the Yorkshire Dales National Park Authority has made an Order, the effect of which is to prohibit any person from proceeding along part of Footpath No. 37 in the Parish of Arkengarthdale in the district of Richmondshire for a distance of approximately 28 metres from 27 September, 2019 until 5 March, 2020 inclusive.

This Order follows emergency notices dated 5 September, 2019 until 26 September, 2019 inclusive.

The closure will be put into effect when necessary by means of the erection of notices and signs.

There is no suitable, off-road alternative route to be used during the closure period. The nearest river crossing is via the road bridge at Whaw to the north west GR NY 9823 0444.

The closure is for public safety due to the collapse of the abutments and the bridge being washed onto the bankside.

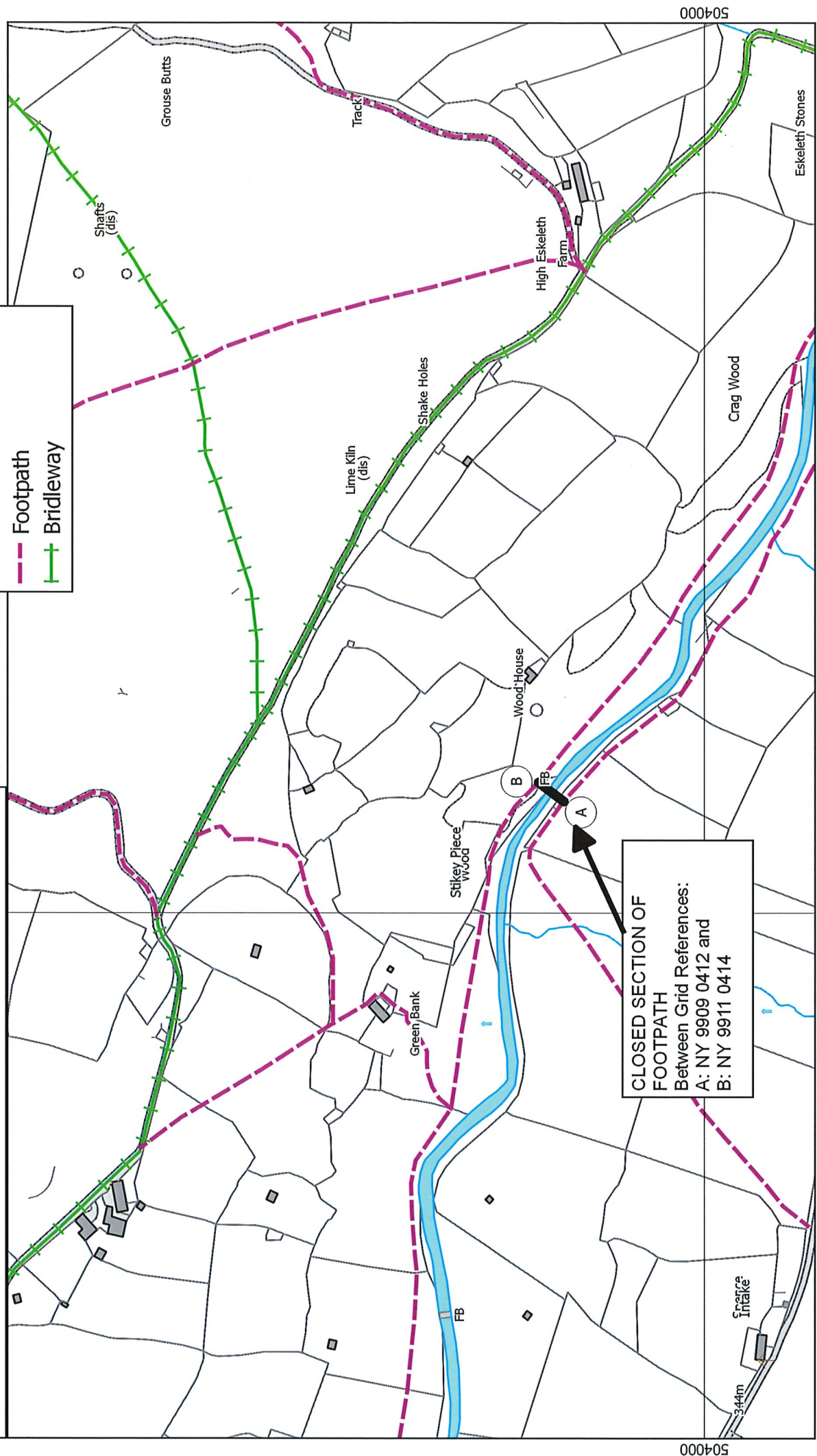
