

# **PUBLIC NOTICE**

**(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF PEDESTRIANS)**

**(FOOTPATH NO. 9 (PART), GRINTON)**

**ORDER 2019, No. 6**

**Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1) (as amended)**

Notice is hereby given that the Yorkshire Dales National Park Authority has made an Order, the effect of which is to prohibit any person from proceeding along part of Footpath No. 9 in the Parish of Grinton in the district of Richmondshire for a distance of approximately 235 metres from 27 September, 2019 until 5 March, 2020 inclusive.

This Order follows emergency notices dated 5 September, 2019 until 26 September, 2019 inclusive.

The closure will be put into effect when necessary by means of the erection of notices and signs.

The alternative route to be used during the closure period will be as follows:-

From the point of closure at Grid Reference SE 0487 9653 along the track and bridleway in a south easterly direction for approx. 512 metres to join the footpath bearing west and then south west before turning north westerly following the gill to point of closure at GR SE 0494 9633 and return.

The closure is for public safety due a historic and listed stone arch culvert adjacent to the mill being completely washed away by the floods and which carried the footpath, now impassable.
