(BRIDLEWAY NO. 9 (Part), REETH, FREMINGTON & HEALAUGH)

ORDER 2019, No. 3

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1) (as amended)

Notice is hereby given that the Yorkshire Dales National Park Authority has made an Order, the effect of which is to prohibit any pedestrian, cyclist and horse rider from proceeding along part of Bridleway No. 9 in the Parish of Reeth, Fremington and Healaugh in the district of Richmondshire for a distance of approximately 1.7 km from 14 September, 2019 until 21 February, 2020 inclusive.

This Order follows emergency notices dated 23 August, 2019 until 13 September, 2019 inclusive.

The closure will be put into effect when necessary by means of the erection of notices and signs.

The Order is necessary for reasons of public safety due to at least three major landslides across the bridleway making it unstable and unsafe to use in its current condition.

There is no suitable alternative route to be used during the closure period.
