(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF PEDESTRIANS)

(FOOTPATH NO. 14 (PART), ARKENGARTHDALE)

ORDER 2019, No. 16

Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14(1) (as amended)

Notice is hereby given that the Yorkshire Dales National Park Authority has made an Order, the effect of which is to prohibit any person from proceeding along part of Footpath No. 14 in the Parish of Arkengarthdale in the district of Richmondshire for a distance of approximately 35 metres from 27 September, 2019 until 5 March, 2020 inclusive.

This Order follows emergency notices dated 5 September, 2019 until 26 September, 2019 inclusive.

The closure will be put into effect when necessary by means of the erection of notices and signs.

The alternative route to be used during the closure period will be as follows:-

From the point of closure at Grid Reference NY 9757 0560 south west to Shepherd's Lodge before bearing north west for approx. 786 metres to Park Head, following the footpath in a northerly direction to New Bridge and Dale Head before bearing south east passing through Hill Top Farm and following the footpath south for approx. 548 metres before turning west, south westerly to point of closure at GR NY 9760 0560 and return.

The closure is for public safety due to the bridge being washed away, leaving substantial river bank erosion and a much wider crossing.
