

Bolton Abbey Route: For All/Some



Bolton Abbey

Route type: For all/some. A linear walk along the River Wharfe through the Bolton Abbey Estate – OS Explorer Map OL2

Distance: 1.8km (each way) for all, 3.7km (each way) for some.

Start point: SE077552

Turning point: SE064563 (for all) SE052574 (for some)

Facilities: Wheelchair accessible toilets are available at the Cavendish Pavilion. There are public parking facilities - including designated bays for blue badge holders - at Sandholme car park. Pre-booked wheelchairs and electric scooters are available for visitors to use between April and October.

Getting there: Car: From Skipton take A59 signposted towards Harrogate. At the Bolton Bridge roundabout, turn left towards Bolton Abbey onto the B6160. Turn right at the Cavendish memorial to reach the Sandholme car park.

The Route

For the first 1.8km of the route, the surface is compact stone at a width of at least 200cm. There are passing places and accessible benches along the full length of the route. Most of the route is flat with some areas having a gradient up to 1:10. From here, the route is unsurfaced with some gradients reaching 1:6.
